MEGACITIES

Where do I even start? Our coordinating team has shrunk down to just 3 of us now, but it's been great! I really really love working with this ministry and getting to see a whole new level of what God is doing throughout the city in different regions and with different pastors! It is so encouraging to meet with pastors and hear about how MegaCities has impacted their churches and their regions. Just last week, we were meeting with a pastor on the east side of town who has had 3 different teams this year but doesn't currently have one. He began to tell us all about how, even now that they don't have a team with us, people from his church have been meeting up with some people from other local churches in his area each Saturday to continue to do evangelism, and how they've been able to plant 3 new churches this year--2 of which have been started by people who were miraculously healed (a blind lady who received sight and a crippled man who was healed) and both of which have already outgrown their current locations and are looking for bigger buildings! And the story doesn't stop there!!!! He told us that their youth group has

quadrupled in numbers and that his church and many other churches have grown by as much as a third since MegaCities began in March. We were absolutely blown away by the incredible testimony of this humble pastor! And that is just a part of one story of many that we've heard of! Just this Wednesday, I was out translating for some seminars with our current speaker in the city, Tom Hallas, who is one of our top leaders in YWAM. We were at our first location, a local university. After the seminar, the director of that college came up to us, just glowing, and let us know that she is a Christian and had no idea that we were Christians when she'd booked us (because we had gone through another contact in the area that works in the government) and she was just thrilled to know that her students had just been confronted with the truth of who God is! That same day, our same contact set up a seminar in a local church that we had been trying to get involved with but hadn't been able to. There, we got to really connect with the pastor--this young woman who is on fire for God and sincerely



desiring teaching in how to start ministries to street children and prostitutes! It was just incredible as well, especially because we have a speaker coming to the city in a few weeks who specializes in working with at risk children! And that's not all.... I could not believe how many people we met that day from the government in that delegation of the city who are Christians! They're all from different churches and backgrounds, but they've become friends through their jobs and are now praying together and really making a difference in their work place! I am continually amazed by all the different things God is doing here and all the amazing people I've had the privilege to meet!
